What can I expect?

Reach has offered counselling to many hundreds of people since 1986. Our aim is to provide acceptance and understanding to all who come for help. We seek to enable people to work through their own difficulties and choices as they wish, by offering counselling for all in a professional environment. You will be allocated the most appropriate counsellor based on your situation.

Who are the counsellors?

We have a team of trained counsellors, most of whom counsel voluntarily. All our counsellors are Christians and are sensitive and committed to respecting each person's beliefs and choices. They are answerable to the Co-ordinator and to the Board of Trustees. We are affiliated to the Association of Christian Counsellors. The service is monitored regularly through evaluation by clients and support for counsellors.

Where would I have to go?

We are based in South Liverpool; and we also counsel in Manchester, West Kirby, New Brighton, Chester, Southport and Sheffield. Appointments for all areas can be made through the Liverpool office.

Could you help me?

We see those who need time and space to talk through and work through their difficulties in a confidential setting. We frequently see people who are struggling with:

- Depression
- Abuse
- Marital / Relationship problems
- Bereavement
- Eating Disorders
- Anxiety and stress
- Spiritual problems
- Other issues.

A couple of our counsellors are able to see children under 17 years of age, though this can usually only be done with parental consent

What does it cost?

We require a £5 fee to be returned with the registration form. We have no fixed fee for counselling but we welcome donations and encourage a 'fair donation principle' which is £1 per session per £1000 of annual income. (e.g. £15 per session for someone with £15,000 annual income).

As a registered charity we are primarily funded through individual giving.
